Peter Ismert (1961 -) Peter Ismert (1961-) has lived most of his life in San Francisco, before recently settling in Liverpool.

His references - clearly linked to the first part of Cubism - are expressed in an organized assemblage whosesense of composition eventually reveals itself in their titles. In this way, we return to an image that has appeared deformed, often still lifes or the artist's intimate childhood memories.

« I have been creating since I was very young; this is my only constancy.

I work with acrylics, collage and drawing on a variety of surfaces, including canvas and wood.

While visual experience guides my process and decision making, my work seems to fall somewhere between the recognizable world and the totally abstract world.

It is indeed a synthesis of visual experience combined with internal thought, distilled through the painting process. »




